Please read all carefully, **sign** and **return the first page** to the school office, you may keep the guidance and advice for your own reference. Due to the rise in tourists returning to the island along with SEC families returning from overseas it is important that we remain vigilant and adhere to the guidelines as closely as possible. We ask that you please take this advice seriously and that we have your full cooperation and understanding.

Waiver of Liability

By signing this agreement, I agree to hold **South East Coast International School** entirely free from any liability, including financial responsibility for health issues due to CORONA/COVID19 that may occur **during the attendance of school by my child.**

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the risks involved in **sending my child to school**, while understanding that the school, its management and staff is providing safety measurements at its utmost capability.

By signing,

- **I agree** to monitor my child's health and my child will not attend the school if he/she shows **ANY** symptoms of illness, especially fever, throat ache, coughing, loss of smell/taste and/or flu-like symptoms.
- **I agree** If these symptoms persist for more than 48hrs, I will endeavor to visit a pediatrician to seek advice on if my child should get a CORONA/COVID-19 test.
- **I agree** my child will only return to school if symptom free for at least 48 hrs and provide a pediatrician report stating my child is safe to return to school.
- **I agree** (if advised by the pediatrician) to take my child for a CORONA/COVID-19 test that if the results are positive to isolate my child for 14 days and to get a second test providing a negative result as clearance in order for my child to return school.
- **I agree** to keep my child away from school in case they had any close contact with people showing CORONA/COVID19 symptoms.
- **I agree**, if arriving from overseas with my child, to provide a negative CORONA/COVID19 test for my child or to self-isolate for 14 days prior to bringing my child to school.

I will make every effort to obey safety precautions as listed in writing on the school grounds, in emails/written communication and as explained to me verbally. I will ask for clarification when needed.



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Please read the attached advice and guidance carefully.

COVID Guidance

If anyone in your household has any of these symptoms, please do not send your child to school:

- **High Temp - over 37.8**
- **New, continuous cough - this means coughing a lot, for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours**
- **A loss of or change to sense of smell or taste - this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal**

Any person experiencing these symptoms should be kept off school and should arrange to be tested for Covid-19 immediately and the school notified through the normal channels - either email or telephone call to the office. The whole family need to isolate, this includes, siblings and children where parents are displaying symptoms.

The household should remain isolated until a negative test result is received as 'clearance'. Please inform school of the result as soon as it is received by emailing: **admin@seczanzibar.com** or **Phone: +255 776 914 788**

Please email even it is during the evening or weekend. This email address will be monitored 24/7.

Typical symptoms of a cold, such as runny nose or a sore throat, are not considered symptoms of corona virus, and as such children do not need to be kept off school unless they are too unwell to attend.

COVID TEST REQUIREMENTS

Those who needs COVID-19 test should go to:

- Zanzibar Public Health Emergency Operations Centre. The ZPHEOC is located at Kinazini and it is in the same building alongside KICHOCHO building, within Lumumba Secondary School compound. The school is clearly marked on google maps.
- Or any other designated facilities approved by the Ministry of Health

The procedure for testing as follows:

- The samples will be taken from using nasopharyngeal and oropharyngeal swabs as per international regulation. The results of the test will be issued within 72 hours
- If your result is negative, you will be issued the COVID-19 negatives certificate from Ministry of Health
- Those that test positive will have to undergo treatment as stipulated by the Government and only issued certificate once fully recovered.
- Cost of test are as follow;
 - \$80 for foreign and tourists,
 - 45,000/= for expat residents or EAC citizens,
 - 30,000/= for TZ citizens.
- The above cost is only for Government facilities, the private facilities have their own cost
- Our customers are advised to pay this to any branch of the Peoples' Bank of Zanzibar.
- Please note opening times of banks, and they are closed Saturday pm and Sunday.

- Once payment is made, take the bank receipt together with your passport copy / residence permit / national ID as applicable, to the testing facility.
